Customer Challenges:

The St. Anthony Medical Center's two Trane Centrifugal chillers provided reliable performance for nearly thirty years. When it came time to update to a new machine, St. Anthony had to look no further than Trane who had been maintaining the chilled water plant for decades.

St. Anthony was not simply swapping a new machine in place of the old one. Instead, due to some remodeling, the Chiller plant was moving to a new location to make valuable room in the facility.

Trane Solutions to the Challenges of the Project:

Trane replaced the two existing 350 ton centrifugal chillers with one 700 ton machine. The chilled water piping had to be extended to the new chiller plant location. Trane provided all of the engineering, project development, installation, project management, commissioning, maintenance and warranty for this project.

General Description of the Building:

St. Anthony Medical Center is located in Crown Point, Indiana. It is a 245 bed facility which employs 1400 professionals and nearly 400 volunteers. The hospital was first constructed in 1974.
